Start of the 2022 School Year



Classes begin for children on MONDAY 31st JANUARY 2022 at 8:45am.

The Office will be open the week before children start school from **MONDAY 24th JANUARY 2022** between the hours of **9:00am - 4:00pm** for families wanting to purchase uniform and/or pay any school fees.

A reminder that school fees will be invoiced in full at the beginning of the year and statements will be issued at the beginning of Term 1. Fees will be payable by the end of each term, unless negotiated otherwise. A 5% discount will apply to fees paid in full by **Friday 18th**March 2022.

The 2022 Parent Information Booklet with essential information for the year will be distributed to all families in the first week of school.

Lunch Orders in 2022
